Do you ever think about 'awe' and 'wonder'? If so, does worship ever fit that description? I know, it's a pretty laden comment, but there are ways that we approach worship that will almost definitely set us up for failure.

How can worship and awe be more connected in our experience?

Today we will be looking at Part 2 of Walk through the Bible, focusing on Genesis 12-50. The focus will be on Genesis 12:1-9 under the heading "The Promise" looking at the promises God makes to Abram. When read with Genesis 1-11 in mind it becomes clear that these are actually God's promises to reverse the effects of sin and the fall. While the focus will be on Genesis 12 I want to show how these promises play out in the rest of the book, in particular that they are constantly under threat, usually because of human failings. But despite these God comes through. Overall message thrust will be on the proactive God who takes the initiative in rescuing the world – and the nature of that rescue – that its not by human will, strength or cunning, but by the power, might and faithfulness of God.
